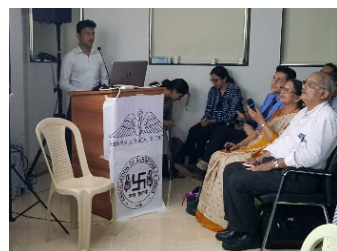
AGM:

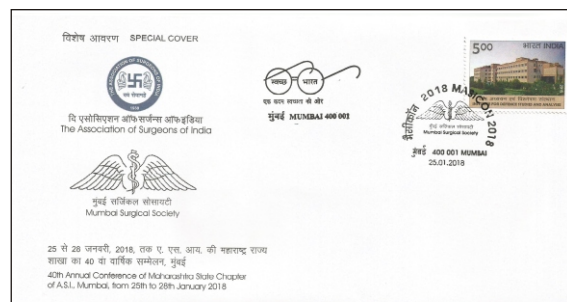

Special Cover: Commemorative First Day Cover, for the 40th MASICON, and 1st of Mumbai Surgical Society, was designed and released on 25th Jan. 2018 during the CME Inauguration.

History:

22nd March, 2014, was the historical date, when 40 surgeons, got together to agree to a proposal floated for establishing an academic group. It was called 'Mumbai Surgical Society'. The first meeting took place in the presence of seniors like, Dr. P. B. Desai, Dr. V. N. Shrikhande, Dr. S. K. Mathur, Dr. S. V. Nadkarni, Dr. Lalit Kapoor, Dr. J. B. Agarwal, and Dr. Pramod Shinde, MASI President, to name a few. As simple ceremony of 'Lighting of the Lamp' with the chanting of sanskrit shloks, inception of a new entity began with the formation of a committee. Thus began, writing of the constitution of MSS.
